What is ClickView?

ClickView is an easy-to-manage platform which provides access to your school's digital video library. It offers schools greater speed and convenience when accessing digital content from their *ClickView* Library Server via URL links. This means that any video from your entire library can be viewed by hundreds of users at the same time across your existing network.

For further information about *ClickView*, go to www.clickview.co.uk.

Eclipse.net enables you to import the *ClickView* xml file into the Resources table so that your borrowers can watch videos after performing a search and clicking on the link.

How do I import the ClickView file?

1. Firstly, obtain a copy of the *ClickView* xml file from the *ClickView* server. It will usually be found in **%ProgramFiles%\ClickView\ClickView Library\ClickViewDataFeed.xml**
2. Place the copy of this xml file somewhere it will easily be found when using Eclipse.net.
3. In Eclipse.net, log in and open **Management**.
4. Whilst in the **Resources** table, click on **Tools / Import** from the top horizontal menu bar (Fig. 1).
5. Select **ClickView** from the list (Fig. 2.1).
6. Browse and select the **xml** file that was copied in step 2 (Fig. 2.2).
7. Click on the **Import** button (Fig. 2.3).

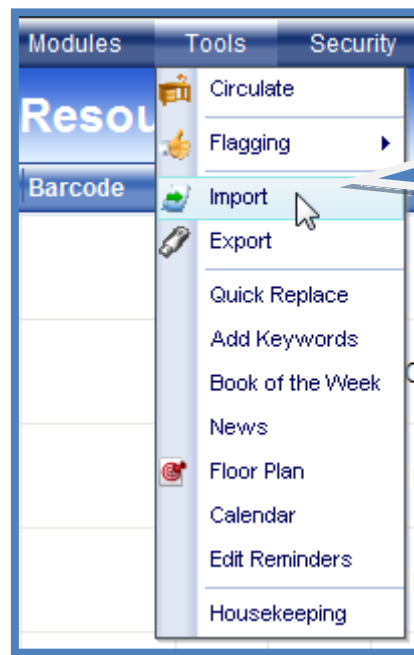

Select **Import** from this menu whilst in Eclipse.net **Management**.

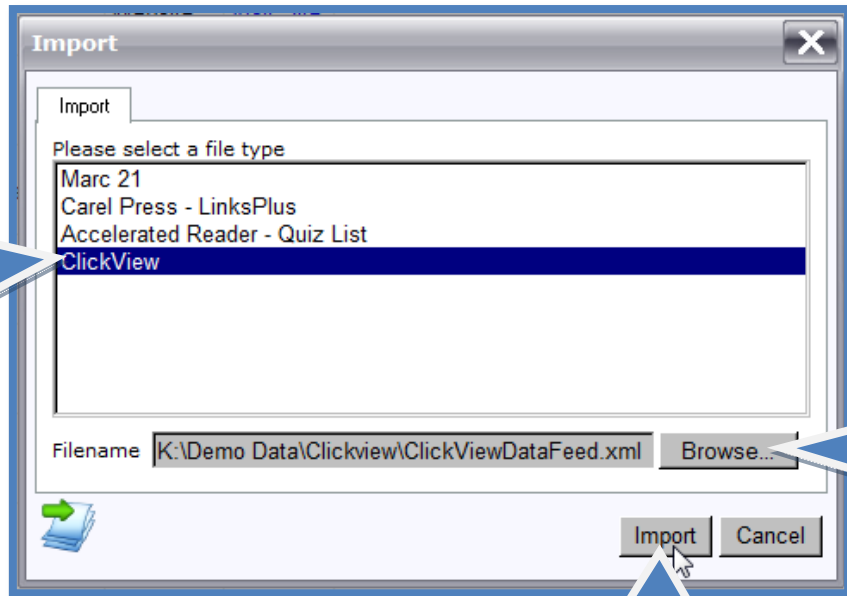

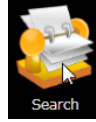
Browse for the ClickView **xml** file.

Click **Import** to begin inserting the video feed into Eclipse.net.

Where do I find the ClickView video feeds?

1. From the Eclipse.net home page, click on **Search**.



2. Click on **Views** to see a list of predefined page views.



3. Select the **ClickView** icon, a list of results is displayed.



4. Click on a search result to open that **video** feed.
